Nigeria, Senegal, Gambia, Guinea, Guinea Bissau, Sierra Leone, Burkina Faso, Togo, Ivory Coast, Mali, Niger, Liberia, Benin and Cape Verde. Singapore, Trinidad and Tobago, Mauritius, South Africa, Lesotho, Botswana, Namibia, Malawi, Swaziland, Tanzania, Uganda, Zimbabwe, Kenya and Rwanda.

#### Climate:

In Accra, temperatures in July generally range between approximately 23 degree celsius to 28 degree celsius, offering a refreshing environment for visitors to explore the city's rich history and interesting sites.

# **Electricity:**

The standard voltage in Ghana is 220 - 240V and the standard frequency is 50Hz. Two round pin plugs and three-pin plugs are frequently used. Participants are reminded to bring their own adapters and transformers.

# **Mode of Electronic Payments:**

International credit cards including Visa, and Master Card are accepted at major business establishments in Ghana.

## **Smoking:**

Smoking restrictions are applicable at indoor public places including meeting venues in Accra.

## **Travel and Transportation**

Kotoka International Airport is approximately 8km away from the workshop venue (approximately 16 minutes drive). Participants arriving at Kotoka International Airport should kindly remember to bring along an international vaccination card as this will be inspected upon arrival.

Please be reminded that transportation from the Kotoka International Airport to the hotel and back will be provided by the workshop organizers. Participants lodging at the three official Event hotels will also be transported to and from the conference venue on a daily basis.

# **Cape Coast Castle**

Fortified castle that is one of the biggest and best-preserved of the slave castles along the coast of West Africa. It began in 1555 as a Portuguese trading post called Cabo Corso ("Short Cape"), from which it got its name.



# **Jamestown Lighthouse**

Situated on the Prof. Atta Mills High Street in Accra, The Lighthouse stands as a historic emblem in Jamestown. This iconic landmark, comprised of a tower and an adjacent maintenance residence, dates back to its initial construction by the British in 1871.



#### Kwame Nkrumah Mausoleum

Dedicated to the prominent Ghanaian leader Osagyefo Dr. Kwame Nkrumah, the memorial complex was dedicated in 1992, and is situated on the site of the former British colonial polo grounds, where the independence of Ghana was declared in Accra.

# Kakum National Park, Cape Coast

The Kakum national park encompasses an area of 145 square miles (375 sq km). The park is named after the Kakum River. This is Ghana's most visited natural attraction. The prominent landscape of the park is tropical forest accounting for 90% of the park landscape.
